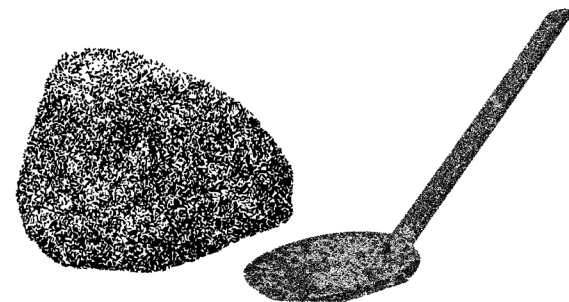




# STONE SOUP
